Hence, range bound oscillation with a negative bias is most likely. staying cautious on rise around 17200 is advised. Down trending index majors may again find sellers on rise.

On the Nifty hourly chart, failing to rise above 17200 is concern, which may push the Index into a bearish range bound oscillation.

Nifty patterns on multiple periods suggesting; bearish shooting star candle suggesting weakness likely to persist. Broader downtrend is still intact, hence, staying cautious on rise is advised.

Stocks Fluctuate as Bank Jitters Cast Long Shadow

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A gauge of Asian equities was slightly lower in choppy trading Friday as the malaise hanging over the banking sector cast a shadow over the economic outlook and markets. Shares swung between gains and losses in Hong Kong, as did US futures, while contracts for Europe remained lower. Financials were among the worstperforming sector on MSCI Inc.'s Asia-wide index. Despite the Nasdaq 100 pushing near to the threshold of a bull market Thursday, banking stocks missed out on the rally and a measure of US financial heavyweights sank to the lowest since November 2020. That tone carried over into Asia. Treasury yields remained volatile and on course for a third day of declines while the dollar steadied after after weakening in the previous six sessions as investors positioned for the Federal Reserve to slash interest rates later this year. Short-dated Treasuries posted outsized moves for an 11th straight trading day Thursday and fluctuated Friday. Traders remain wary of problems in the banking sector that have built up during Fed's rapid hiking cycle. The US lenders slumped even after Treasury Secretary Janet Yellen told lawmakers she was prepared for further steps to protect deposits if needed.

Oil Declines Amid Bank Concerns, US Caution on Stockpile Refill

Oil fell, paring a weekly advance, as concerns over the banking industry simmered and the US signaled that refilling the nation's strategic crude inventories would take longer than previously expected. West Texas Intermediate declined toward \$69 a barrel after a choppy session on Thursday that ended with a drop. Still, the US benchmark has risen by about 4% this week. Malaise continues to hang over the US banking sector, despite an assurance of more support from the authorities if warranted.

Great Lakes Oil Pipeline Tunnel Faces Two-Year Army Corps Delay

Enbridge Inc.'s plan to build an oil pipeline tunnel underneath a key waterway in the Great Lakes suffered a setback on Thursday after the US Army Corps of Engineers delayed an environmental review of the project by two years. The draft environmental impact statement on the Line 5 tunnel through the Straits of Mackinac which connect Lake Michigan and Lake Huron — was originally set to be published in late 2023, but now won't be released until spring 2025, the Army Corps said on its website. Enbridge's Line 5 carries oil from Wisconsin to Ontario and crosses Michigan's upper and lower peninsulas along the bed of the straits. Enbridge wants to build a tunnel around the pipeline to reduce the risk of an oil spill as it continues to operate the conduit in defiance of Michigan Governor Gretchen Whitmer's order to shut it entirely. Enbridge and Whitmer have been enmeshed in a court battle for several years, and the dispute has roiled relations between the US and Canada, which relies on Line 5 to supply oil refineries in Quebec and Ontario.
